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Disconnect power to the unit before servicing. Follow all lock out/tag out procedures established by the user. Verify all power is off to the unit before performing any work.

Failure to comply could result in serious injury, death or damage to the equipment.



WARNING:

1. Remove lower front panel and discard.

Refer to Figure 1. for cold plate units.

2. Disconnect the "Z" style front cold plate drain assembly by removing the (4) screw type hose clamps from the cold plate black drain elbows. Complete the Z drain removal by loosening the hose clamp that connects the Z drain assembly to the unit drain line.




Figure 2.

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

Refer to Figure 2. for the following Steps.

3. Connect the existing unit drain line to the drip tray drain tube or install a new unit drain line assembly using items 6, 7 and 15. To provide for proper drainage, make sure the drain line runs flat with the bottom of the dispenser and contains no "traps". Route the unit drain line to an open drain. The drain line must continuously pitch downward to the open drain and contain no traps or improper drainage will result.




IMPORTANT:

This equipment must be installed with adequate back flow protection to comply with applicable federal, state, and local codes.

- 4. Mount the drip tray / extension assembly to the unit base with the (3) pins provided in the kit.
- 5. Install the new lower panel with the (2) 8-32 screws and captivating washers provided.
