



IDC Pro: Formatting and Adding NEW Brand or Flavor Shot Images



- Resources -> Product Images -> Brand Icon Library -> IDC Pro Fountain -> Select Appropriate Folder -> Save Icon -> Transfer to USB -> Follow steps below for **Adding Band Icons and Creating Syrup Profiles**


Follow the steps below if you need to create or format an account specific Brand or Flavor Shot for IDC Pro. If already formatted properly, skip to Adding Brand Icons and Creating Syrup Profiles.

How to properly format a Brand or Flavor Shot icon for IDC Pro.


- Save images to your computer (my documents)
- Open Microsoft Paint
- Drag file from computer into Microsoft Paint
- Select "Resize"



- Select "Pixels"
- Unselect "Maintain aspect ratio"
- Type in format
 - Brands = 175 x 175
 - Flavor Shots = 225 x 225



- Select "OK"
- "Save as PNG file"






Creating Syrup Profiles

- a. Access the service UI



Tap each corner of the video screen starting in the upper right corner. Continue to each corner in a counterclockwise direction, in the form of a “C”. The screen will flash white when you touch corners. Wait for the video to reappear before proceeding to the next touch point.


- b. Enter the correct Access code:3333



- c. Access the “Unit Setup” screen.




- d. Access the “Syrup Edit” screen.





- e. Select the  icon to add a new syrup. Do not select this more than once per syrup.



- f. Select the white area under the “Name” field to edit the name of brand/flavor shot.




Change the name of the new brand or flavor shot. Select Enter when finished.


- g. Select the white area under “Syrup Type” and set to “Flavor” or “Brand”



- h. Select Water type if adding a brand – Full carb for carbonated brands and Plain Water for non-carbonated brands

- i. Note: Water type will not appear when adding flavor shots

- i. Select the white area under “Ratio” and set the ratio to the syrup manufacturer recommended ratio.




Enter correct ratio and select enter






j. Select Save




k. Enter calorie information



Adding new brand or flavor image

l. Select the "Add/Del Images" button to upload the new Brand or Flavor Shot image from your attached USB flash drive.





- m. You will see the name of your USB flash drive appear under “Attached Media.” Select the USB Flash drive name (example below is “Centon USB”) to view your files within the flash drive. USB will depend on your USB.




- n. Once you’ve opened your flash drive, select the new Brand or Flavor Shot image file so it is highlighted in blue, and then select the  icon to copy this image to local media files.



Select “Back” once completed.

- o. Locate and select the new Brand or Flavor shot profile just created. They are displayed in the list on the left in alphabetical order. The Edit Syrup Data on the right should match what was just created.


- p. Select the  symbol under “Image” to view all syrup artwork loaded to the unit.



Select the new artwork that you just loaded. It should match the new Brand or Flavor Shot profile you just created.



q. Select Save in the small box followed by Save in the big box



Once saved, select cancel to return to the Unit Setup page

Mapping New Brand or Flavor Shot

Use the Brand/Flavor Mapping (found in “Unit Setup”) function to map the new Brand or Flavor Shot to the correct valve.
